LIGHT NIGHT AT NOTTINGHAM CASTLE

- **VISIONS OF THE CUT** - MA Museum and Heritage Development students from the School of Arts and Humanities at Nottingham Trent University (NTU) have curated a dynamic projection of contemporary and archival canal photography.
- **EN ROUTE TO THE OCEAN** - local artist Anna Roebuck has made installations from waste objects to decorate this heritage environment, including birds and fish from plastic waste for an installation in water.
- **120 GREEN BOTTLE SITTING ON THE WALL** - local artist Sarah Turner has worked in schools to decorate 120 bottles with images of wildlife and fill them with light to illuminate the walls as you approach the Enchanted Water site.

- **THE LIVERPOOL LANTERN COMPANY** - discover some exciting wildlife puppets as you explore the Enchanted water site and be mesmerized by their grace and playfulness.
- **VINTAGE TRAM** - a projection onto a building on Carrington Street of the film of Mitchell and Keyon made of the first Nottingham Tram Ride in 1902.
