1 OUR BEATING HEART

Old Market Square

This unique and mesmerising heart-shaped artwork is composed of a massive rotating mirror ball, adorned with over 11,000 mirrored tiles. As the sculpture rotates slowly, it illuminates the surrounding space with a dazzling display of light, creating a magical atmosphere.
